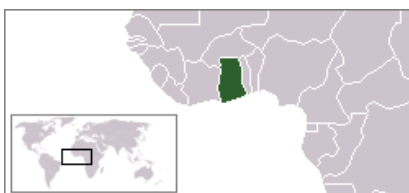


Business Trip to Ghana – 13-17 September 2010.

In the West African region, Ghana has emerged as a beacon of growth and political stability. The country offers a wide range of business opportunities in various sectors. Rising incomes, improved infrastructures and the membership of the ECOWAS all contribute to making Ghana the base of choice for doing business throughout West Africa.

The delegation will be received by the Swiss Embassy and acquire access to governmental authorities and promotion institutions.

The trip will also include participation at the investor conference Invest in Madagascar 2010 with numerous presentations of concrete business opportunities and the attendance of private and public stakeholders and relevant local service providers.

Ghana – The gateway to West-Africa.

Continuous efforts to improve the country's business environment and infrastructure have led to steadily increasing foreign direct investments. Ghana features vast untapped land resources, one of the best-educated workforces in Sub-Saharan Africa as well as access to the ECOWAS countries encompassing 250 million consumers.

Through its efficient ports, Ghana is well situated to serve the regional market as well as Europe, Southern Africa and beyond. The country is Africa's second biggest exporter of timber and gold and the world's second largest exporter of cocoa. But besides these traditional export goods, Ghana has also developed a relatively diversified economy with a wide array of investment opportunities in sectors such as Agro Processing, Textile and Garments, Information Technology, Financial Services and Infrastructure. The imminent start of large-scale extraction of crude oil offers further opportunities within the Oil Service sector.

The trip in a nutshell.

The trip will be organised by rainbow unlimited gmbh and Osec in collaboration with the Swiss Embassy in Accra and the Ghana Investment Promotion Centre (GIPC).

The programme will be tailor-made according to individual objectives and needs. Prior to the trip an in-depth-interview with the participants will serve to identify specific expectations.
